We are inviting young folx to collaborate with educators, parents, and community members to prioritize the voices of those who have long been ignored as leaders for change.

We welcome the engagement of young people with diverse, intersectional identities, and encourage young people from all backgrounds to join us in our work. This includes -- but is in no way limited to -- people experiencing disability, BIPOC individuals, and LGBTQIA2S+.

BENEFITS:

Community Advisory Board (CAB) participation provides an opportunity to contribute in a multi-faceted and co-creative environment, connect with like-minded people, gain advocacy experience, collaborate in non-profit work, refine leadership skills, and expand the mission of helping underserved children on a broader scale.

The Shadow Project will work with those youth that choose to engage with the CAB to determine the benefit that is most useful to them, such as: one-month Tri-Met pass, food and drink gift cards, sensory tools, or other resources.
