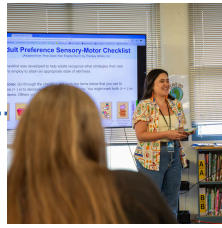

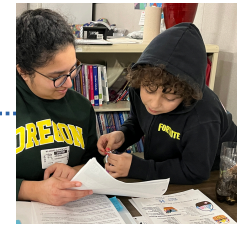

Goal Setting

Tools for teachers that build confidence and skills for students with learning challenges.

- ★ **84%** of teachers said it helped them make students feel welcome and safe
- ★ **77%** of students improved self-motivation
- ★ **76%** of students got better at making responsible decisions

Reading Mentors

Growing reading skills with mentors and technology.

- ★ **63,331** pages read
- ★ **72%** of students built independent reading habits
- ★ **61%** of students increased their self-confidence as readers

SuperSensory Spaces

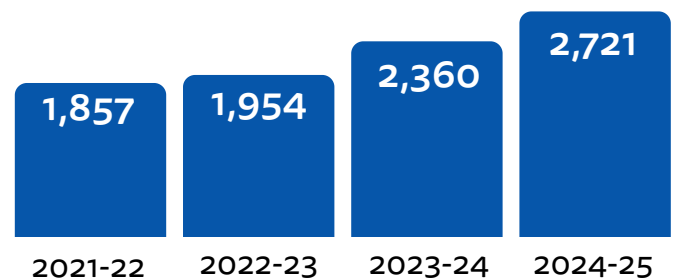
Building emotional self-awareness and coping skills using sensory and movement tools.

- ★ **93%** of Centennial students improved their ability to cope with stress
- ★ **90%** of teachers said these spaces contribute to feelings of belonging and welcome
- ★ **100%** of administrators said the Spaces address a critical need at their school

The right support can change a student's life. Dalilah, a fourth grader, is a perfect example of this. When she first started in our Reading Mentors program, she wasn't so sure about school, but that changed when she was paired with her mentor, Mike.

As Dalilah's confidence grew with her reading, her mentor Mike noticed it spilling over into her other school subjects. After he encouraged her during a tough writing assignment, she later proudly showed him a paper she had completed and even read it aloud to him. This demonstrated how her newfound confidence and perseverance were helping her in all her subjects.



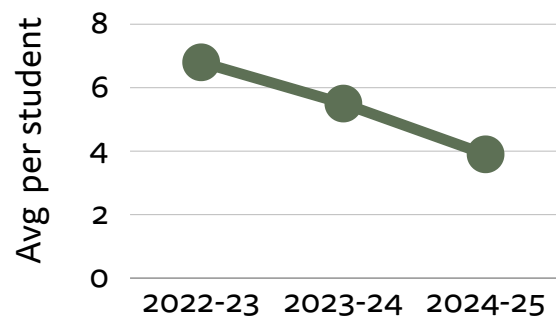

More Learning, Less Struggle

SuperSensory Spaces help students identify their emotions, find coping skills that work for them, and advocate for their needs.

This means they're spending more time in class, learning and connecting with their peers instead of in detention or suspended. And here's proof—for the past two years, the average number of discipline incidents for SuperSensory Space students in the Centennial School District has gone down.
